January 30 was a Super Blue Moon and on January 31 at 5:51am was the Super Blue Blood Moon event. A couple of pictures in case you missed them.








John Rhoades passed away in Arizona on January 27, 2018 at the age of 70. John is survived by his wife, Kathy Rhodes and sister, Pam Strange.
