Dear Valued Customer,

To help customers who rely on well water pumps better prepare for outages and Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) events, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is offering rebates for qualifying backup power generation. This includes a **\$300 rebate**, or a **\$500 rebate** for residential customers enrolled in the California Alternate Rates Energy (CARE) or Family Electric Rate Assistance (FERA) programs.

To be eligible for the Backup Generator Rebate Program, you must:

- Have an active PG&E account
- Reside in a High Fire-Threat District as determined by the California Public Utilities Commission
- Rely on well water pumping for your water needs

Both rebates apply to qualifying backup power generator purchases made from May 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.
