MADERA COUNTY FIRE NORTH FORK STATION 11

Our local Fire Station was staffed on June 12, 2025 with FULL-TIME Cal Fire personnel!!!

The Cal Fire Rancheria Station on Road 200 supplied an engine and is sharing their staff to make this happen. This took a few years and a lot of work to get the buildings of the Station, the bunk house, a bay for Sierra Ambulance, and a Sheriff sub-station.

The North Fork Volunteer Fire Department Auxiliary, (NFVFDA) was instrumental in keeping the drive going to complete the building of the facilities and furnishing the bunk houses. We are grateful to all who made this happen for our town. Some of those who were also instrumental in making this happen is the Mono Tribe, Madera County, and of course, Cal Fire.

FIREWISE

You have turned in a total of 1,574.5 hours of fuel clearances for Cascadel Woods plus paid help of \$1,367.50. Cascadel Heights has turned in 487.5 hours and paid help and other donations of \$7,546.45. This is as of the end of June. Our total hours so far are 2062 times the volunteer rate of \$33.49 per hour equals \$69,056.38, plus the donations of the paid help and other of \$8,913.95 for a grand total for our Firewise USA to date of \$77,970.33. We have accomplished the required number of hours to remain in good standing. Well done everyone!!!!! Keep it going.
