MINUTES

APRIL 13, 2019

10:00 AM – 1:30 AM

Stan Eggink and Brian Curtis cleared fallen trees blocking access to water company facilities. Three water company sites were inspected for hazard trees that could fall onto the access roads. There are standing dead trees, but none that appear to be a urgent hazard. The access roads were cleared of much debris. More work is needed on the access roads. Stan has scheduled a contractor to grade and repair the erosion on the access roads from the harsh winter weather. This work is scheduled for later in April.

Stan and Brian worked for 2.5 hours.

Susie Odry, Ed Rose and Carol Eggink completed the hydrant flushing and clearing of debris around the hydrants. Ed Rose is now trained in the proper procedure of charging and discharging our hydrants. The clubhouse mailbox area was also cleared of debris and mud. The small water runoff was dug out again to help keep water from standing around the mailbox cluster. This area needs to be rid of the dirt behind the mail box cluster to aid in the water flow. Carol will seek assistance from Stan and the CWPOA tractor to eliminate this obstacle. Mud was cleared from a portion of Cascadel North.

Susie, Ed and Carol worked for 1.5 hours.

Carol worked another 2 hours clearing debris from Loma Linda Drive on two private properties.

All total, the Brigade and volunteer, Ed Rose put in 11.5 hours today. The rate of volunteer time is \$24.14. Today's total is \$ 277.61 towards our required total of \$ 4,296.92.

Carol will be scheduling more work days to gather piles for a chipping day in the near future.
